A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MONROE COUNTY, TENNESSEE CONSENTING TO THE ISSUANCE BY THE MONROE COUNTY EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS DISTRICT OF ITS EMERGENCY COMMUNICATION DISTRICT REVENUE BOND, SERIES 2013 AND APPROVING A LEASE BETWEEN THE COUNTY AND THE DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Monroe County Emergency Communications District (the "District") has heretofore determined that it is necessary and advisable to authorize the issuance of a revenue bond of the District for the purpose of obtaining funds to aid in financing improvements to its emergency communications system; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated Section 7-86-114(a), it is necessary to obtain the approval of the county wherein the district is established as to the issuance of said bond of said District.

WHEREAS, the purchaser of the proposed revenue bond has requested that the County and the District enter into a lease of the property described in Exhibit B to the attached form of Lease Agreement (the ''Property''), the term of which must be not less than the term of the proposed bond.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by Monroe County, Tennessee, as follows:

- Section 1. MONROE COUNTY, TENNESSEE, THROUGH IT BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, CONSENTS TO THE ISSUANCE BY THE MONROE COUNTY EMERNGENCY COMMUNICATIONS DISTRICT OF ITS \$315,800 EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS DISTRICT REVENUE BOND, SERIES 2013 PURSUANT TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF A BOND RESOLUTION SUBSTANTIALLY IN THE FORM ATTACHED HERETO AS <u>EXHIBIT A</u>.
- Section 2. MONROE COUNTY, TENNESSEE, THROUGH ITS BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, APPROVES THE LEASE OF THE PROPERTY TO THE DISTRICT PURSUANT TO THE TERMS OF A LEASE IN SUBSTANTIALLY THE FORM ATTACHED HERETO AS <u>EXHIBIT B</u>. AND AUTHORIZES THE COUNTY MAYOR AND OTHER COUNTY OFFICIALS TO CAUSE SUCH LEASE TO BE COMPLETED AND EXECUTED ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY.
