724-22 RESOLUTION: A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE SUBMISSION OF A FAST TRACK INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (FIDP) APPLICATION ON BEHALF OF LOWE'S AND POLYONE CORPORATION

WHEREAS, Monroe County recognizes and supports the need for business expansion within the county; and

WHEREAS, Lowe's and Polyone are serviced by county-owned railroad tracks at the Niles Ferry Industrial Park; and

WHEREAS, Monroe County must repair the railroad tracks in the Niles Ferry Industrial Park so that they can continue to service the Lowe's and PolyOne facilities; and

WHEREAS, the State of Tennessee offers grants to local communities to finance infrastructure improvements that support business expansion and retention through its Fast Track Infrastructure Development Program (FIDP); and

WHEREAS, Monroe County must submit a formal application in order to be eligible for funding through the FIDP program, said application to request funding for the repair of the railroad tracks in Niles Ferry Industrial Park

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Monroe County Commission hereby authorizes the Mayor or his representative to prepare and submit a FIDP grant application for up to \$146,848.00 to partially finance the cost to repair the railroad tracks in the Niles Ferry Industrial Park.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Monroe County Commission agrees to fund 18% of the total project costs, estimated to be \$32,236.00, in order to satisfy the local share requirements of the FIDP program.
