WHEREAS, Monroe County Commission meeting in a Called Meeting on March 10, 2020, amended Resolution 0225-12 which was tabled at the February 25, 2020 Monroe County Commission Meeting, and

WHEREAS, Sheriff Tommy Jones has proposed that the seven (7) new correction officers shall be paid an hourly rate ranging from \$12.88 to a maximum of \$15.92 per hour depending upon the qualifications and experience of the candidates, and

WHEREAS, the Monroe County Commission failed to include this correction in the Amended Resolution 3-10-1.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Monroe County Commission acting in regular session on this 24th day of March, 2020, that the hourly rate of these seven (7) new correction officers be set at a scale ranging from \$12.88 to a maximum of \$15.92 per hour depending upon the qualifications and experience of the candidates.
