


RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE SUSPENSION OF THE MONROE COUNTY WHE TAX

- WHEREAS: One School Board member would be appropriate relative to the population of the Fourth Civil District; and
- WHEREAS: The current Private Act provides for only nine (9) School Board members, three (3) from each of the First, Second and Third Civil Districts; and
- WHEREAS: One of the persons serving as a member of the School Board on the Second Civil District is a resident of the new Fourth Civil District, but was elected to serve as a Second Civil District School Board member and is running unopposed to be reelected to the School Board in the current 2022 election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Monroe County Commission requests the approval of the amendment to the Private Act adding the additional School Board member representing the Fourth Civil District and that the School Board member will be elected in the 2024 election cycle. That the current School Board member representing the Second Civil District, but who is a resident of the Fourth Civil District, be allowed to be a candidate for that seat in that same election and if that creates a vacancy for the Second Civil District School Board seat, then that said vacancy will be filled in that same election.

This Resolution shall be presented to the State Legislature for approval and action as required to amend the Private Act.
